


How do I set up the ICD-10 CM codes?

ICD-10 code setup


1. Navigate to the student MA Forms menu.

2. Click on "ICD-10 Code Setup".
3. Click the "Add New Code" button.


4. Click the "Edit" link.
5. Select the Service type from the drop down and enter a Start Date.

Note: The ICD-10 will need to be selected once for each type of service you plan to bill.

6. Click on the "Select Code" button (if the code is known it can be entered manually).
7. Click on the relevant Chapter and continue to click through options until you have found a billable code to select.

Note: Only billable codes are allowed to be inserted to the ICD-10 code setup page. If a code is not highlighted in blue as a link, it is not billable.



8. Select a "Default Order".
9. Save.
10. Click the SpEd Forms "Back" button to return to the ICD-10 code setup page.
